Feeding Rates

Feeding rates should be adjusted to suit pasture availability, roughage quality, stage of lactation and level of milk production. Feeding rates should be increased when there is little or no green pasture available, roughage quality is low, in early lactation, and for high levels of milk production.

It is important to ensure good quality, clean water is always available and that troughs are cleaned daily.
